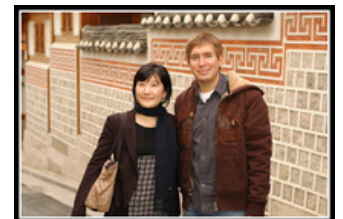

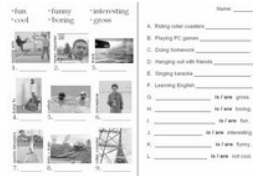

School Newspaper



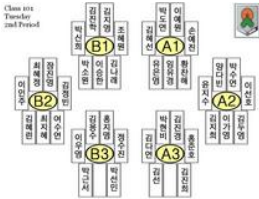
I was asked to write the articles and do the layout for a page of the school paper.
